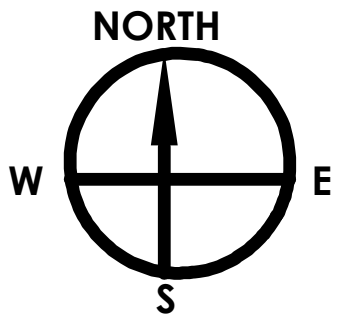


- MMBA Suggested Rider Conduct**
- YIELD the right of way to other trail users.
 - CONTROL your speed and pass with care.
 - WARN other trail users well in advance when overtaking horses and hikers. If necessary, stand off to one side to let oncoming horses go by, and talk to riders as they pass.
 - STAY on designated roads and trails.
 - DON'T disturb wildlife or livestock.
 - PACK OUT litter.
 - RESPECT property - minimize impact by avoiding muddy trails, excessive braking, or crosscutting switchbacks.
 - KNOW local rules.
 - PLAN ahead.
 - AVOID riding alone, or at least let someone know where you plan to go.

- Additional Conduct Suggestions**
- ANTICIPATE other possible trail users, be cautious around blind turns.
 - NEVER Change the physical nature of the trail. This includes cutting trees, or moving rocks and logs. All obstruction should be reported to the local bike organization or Park authorities.
 - REMOVE labels from sports drinks or bottled water bottles, this will prevent the label from becoming garbage on the trail.
 - ALLOW Better riders to pass (slow down and ride to one side of the trail).
 - MAINTAIN your pet! If fido must run with you make sure he is not disturbing someone else's ride time. Obey posted signs regarding pet regulations.
 - BE RESPECTFUL of the locals, you may be on or near private land.
 - BE SMART, don't ride into any situations that may be over your abilities or just plain dangerous
 - PARK in designated locations only
